U kooodu kwuna sumuna na'ootsukwe! Carry a jacket in case it gets cold!


Pesa ka po kumana meana! Make sure that you walk on the sidewalks.



Chi iwa halloween pama llaxaukt ku Tiyamitpama laxaukt. This is Halloween and Fall time Coloring.


Chi iwa maxsh Shantlu This is an orange pumpkin or squash.




Chi iwa chmuk P'uus This is a black cat.
