Ap'úxsnk imiin atáuwait. *Kiss your friend, husband, sweetheart.*

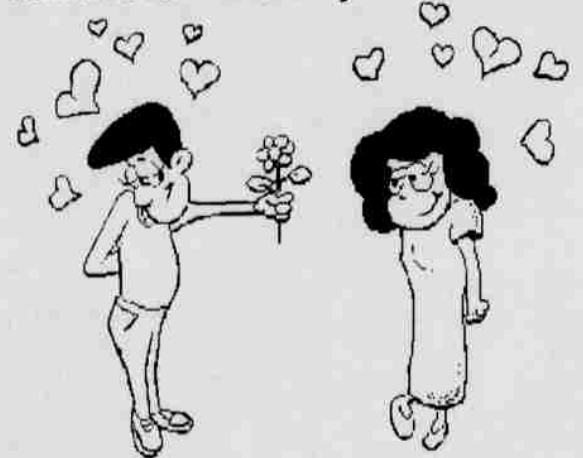
Átauwishamash! *I love you!*
