Let's go outside

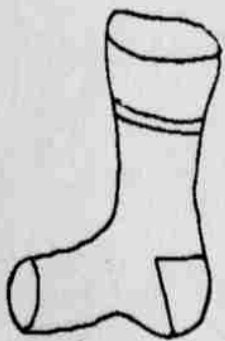
K'st iwamsh amchni.

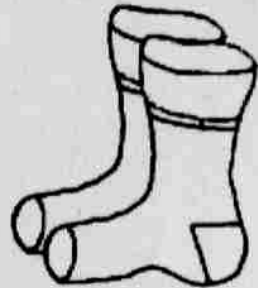

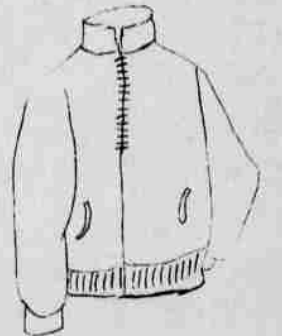
