Fifth staff member at Chemawa on leave

SALEM (AP) — Officials at the Chemawa Indian boarding school in Salem have placed a fifth staff member on administrative leave.

Nedra Darling, spokeswoman for the Bureau of Indian Affairs, would not disclose the name of the staff member, or any specifics about why the person was put on paid leave.

She did say it is not related to the death of Cindy Gilbert Sohappy, 16, on Dec. 6.

Four other staff members — a dormitory manager, one security staff member, and a school administrator — were put on leave after the death of

Sohappy, a Warm Springs tribal member who died of alcohol poisoning while locked in a holding cell at the school, according to federal officials.

The cells are no longer being used, officials said last week, and School Supervisor Larry Byers said last week that intoxicated students now are taken immediately to a medical facility.

The inspector general's Office of the Department of the Interior continues its investigation into the school's policies for handling intoxicated students. The FBI also is conducting a criminal investigation.
