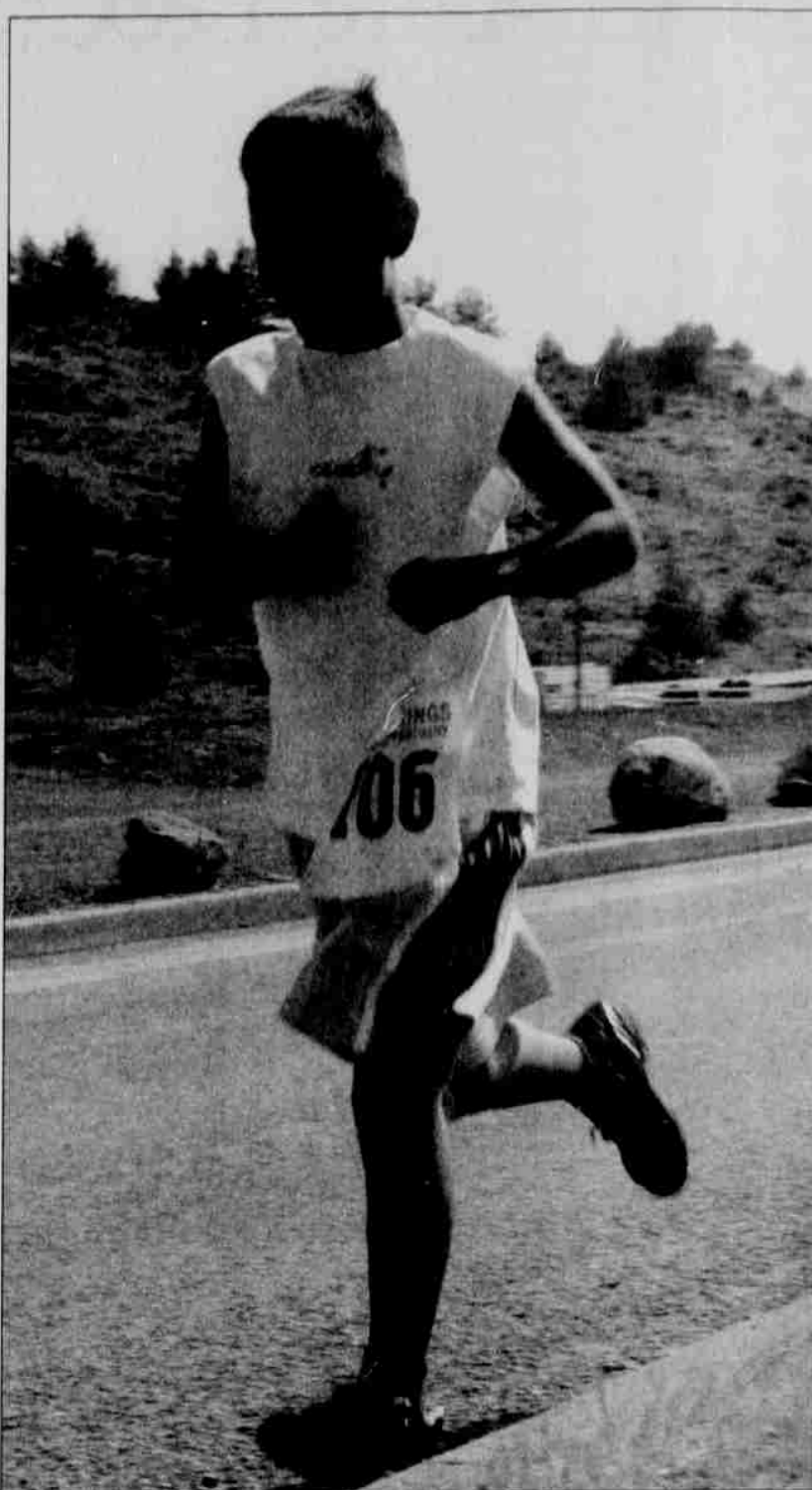
Male 14-18 Justin Berman took 1st at 21:05, Kip Culpus in 2nd at 31:49, and Kelly Blueback took 3rd.
