**Notice of correction regarding the deadline for submitting written comments concerning the proposed plan for the use and distribution of the judgment funds awarded to the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs Reservation in the McQuinn and HeHe claims cases.**

On Jan. 6, 2005, the Bureau of Indian Affairs gave notice that it would hold a hearing of record at 7 p.m. on Jan. 27, 2005, at the Agency Longhouse, Warm Springs, Oregon, to discuss the proposed plan for the use and distribution of the settlement funds awarded to the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation in three cases concerning the McQuinn case and HeHe case.

The deadline for submitting written comments is extended to Jan. 27, 2005. Written comments will be accepted at the hearing of record. Those unable to attend the hearing of record may submit written comments to the Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Northwest Regional Office, at 911 N.E. Eleventh Ave., Portland, OR 97232.
