The Spilyay Tymoo received a call from Roxanne McInturff, owner of Rainbow Market, about the tree, as she noticed it getting thinner at its trunk. Beavers often prefer to eat seaweed, clover and other herbaceous vegetation during warm weather, instead of the green bark (cambium) of trees. In areas with harsh winters, though, they normally need to prepare an underwater food cache of branches.

#### Courses teach computer skills




