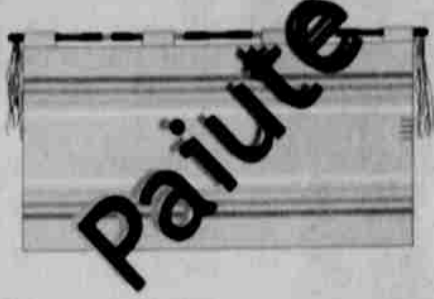

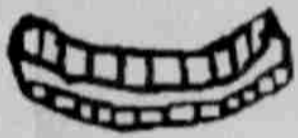


"Starting the Day"

See you this evening.

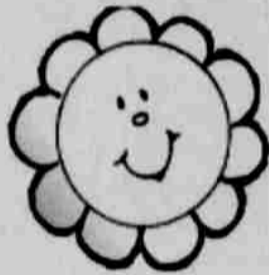

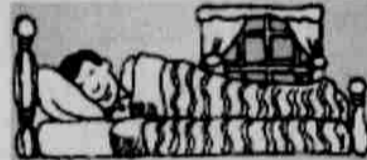


Aga emxigemxatgait shaxel ishtamx

Now let's eat breakfast.

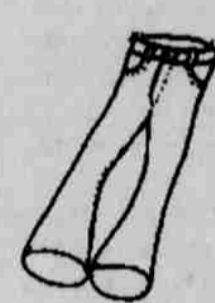


Taxshik
