Notice of trial/hearing

Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon vs. Irene Garcia, defendant. Case No. CR361-05. To Irene Garcia: You are hereby notified that the above cited case, as filed in the Warm Springs Tribal Court, has been scheduled for trial/hearing at 9 a.m. on May 4, 2006. You are hereby ordered to be and appear at the Warm Springs

Tribal Court at the time and date shown to defend against the charge(s). You may be represented by yourself, by an attorney, or by a spokesperson, at your own expense. You may bring any documents you believe are relevant to this cause, and you may bring witnesses to testify on your behalf. You may request the court to subpoena you witnesses; however, you must submit your list of wit-

nesses no later than two weeks prior to trial; failure to do so will not be considered sufficient reason to postpone the trial. If you have questions, you should seek legal advice immediately. If you fail to appear as so ordered, the tribal court may enter a complaint for contempt of court and issue a warrant for your arrest.
