Do you have ideas or concerns about plans for community land use and development?

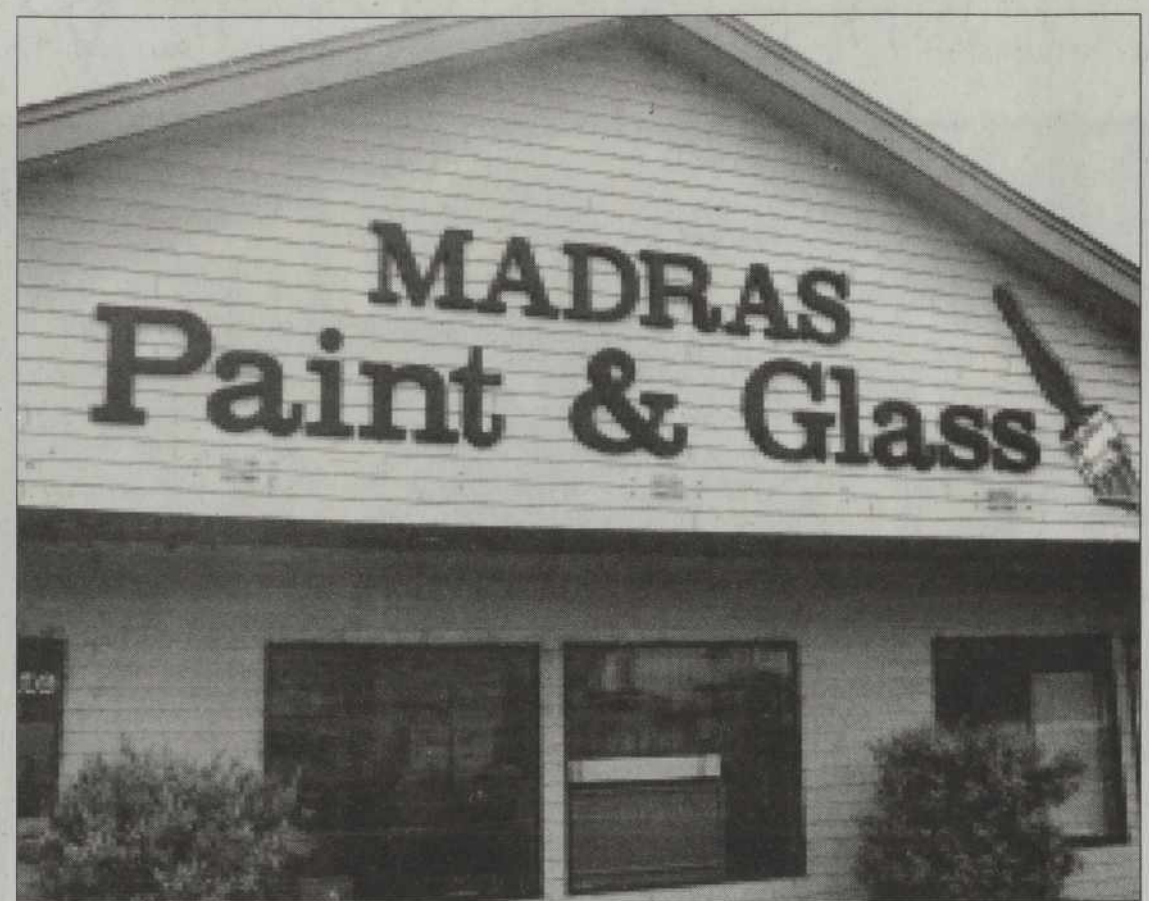

This tournament is open to the first six teams in each division to enter by this Friday, Feb. 16.

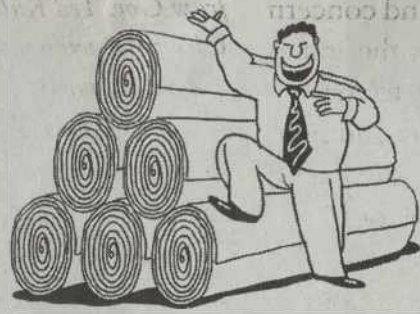
Should there be no response on the girls division, the tournament may open up to boys 11 and under (by required entry deadline.)

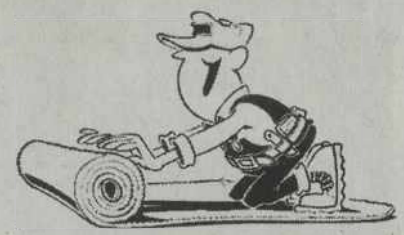

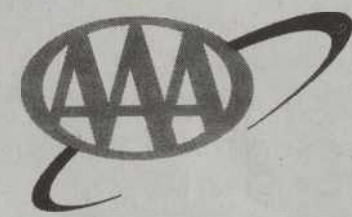
