Today we will be listening to some everyday expressions used and some of the greetings that nobekwi a matsapeku. Maadooe mu matsapeku everyone enjoys hearing.


Key word: Tkwatat (time to eat)

Itwananaásha patupa. It is snowing at Mt. Hood.


