## Healing Wounded Spirits gathering at HeHe

The Healing Wounded Spirits for Youth Conference and gathering will be Monday through Thursday, June 19-22 at the HeHe Campground.

Healing Wounded Spirits for Youth is directed to high school and college age youth. The Thursday, June 22, sessions, "Survivors of Suicide," will be for families who have lost a family member to suicide.

The first day of the gathering, Monday, June 19, starts with

lunch at noon, followed by open camp prayer, setting up camp, quiet time, supper at 6 p.m., introductions, and fun time.

Tuesday begins with breakfast till 8 a.m., followed by Washat, and a discussion on "Healing Wounded Spirits" by Dr. Tom Ball, Klamath and Modoc. At 2:30 p.m., "Rez Dog" Cissy Falcon, of the Umatilla Tribal Program, will speak. There will also be a spirit run, and sweats for females and

males.

Wednesday begins with breakfast and Washat followed by discussion by Dr. Allison Ball, Colville, on the topic of "Recovery, Re-energize, Resilience and Reciprocity." In the evening after supper and sweat house, there will be a round dance with Black Lodge.

Thursday, June 22, begins with Washat for survivors of suicide. There will be discussion at 10:15 a.m. on "Trauma and

Loss for Survivors." There will be an afternoon spirit walk, talk time of the entire group, and at 4 p.m., "Wiping the Tears Ceremony," followed by supper.

There will be a concert by Brule that evening at the Pi-Ume-Sha grounds.

The classes are great for anyone who hasn't had any, or very little, experience using a computer.

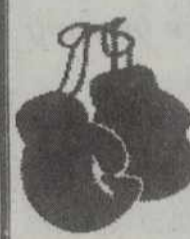
Todd Williver, the instructor, is well known as one of the best computer instructors in the Central Oregon region.
