Ronald Smith recently completed his third summer working for the Natural Resources Depart-


A 16-year-old junior in high school, Smith said he enjoys the summer work he does. 'T've been learning a lot," he added.

He has one brother, 18-year-Smith said he plans to pursue old Ryan Jr., and one sister, 20-






