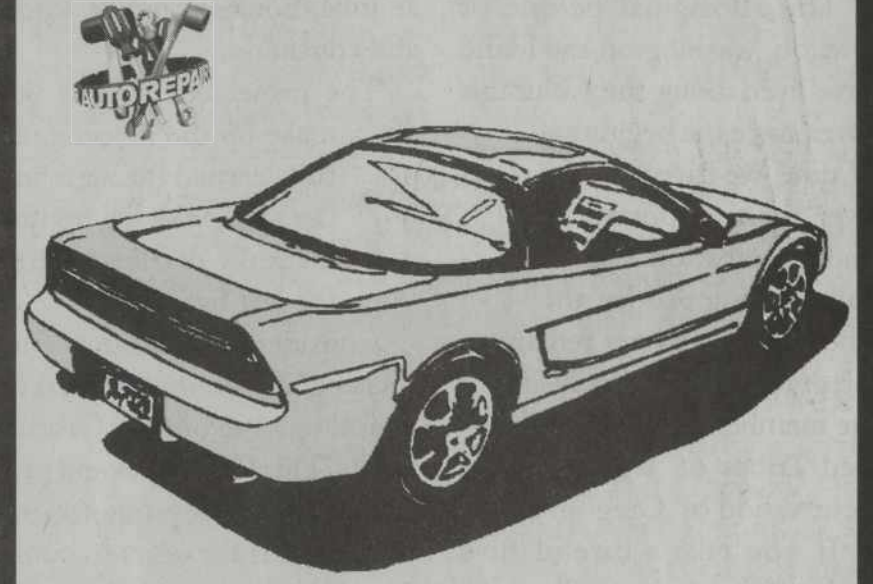

Though he is still unsure of what he wants to study, Smith said he is considering a degree in science—most likely something involving biology.

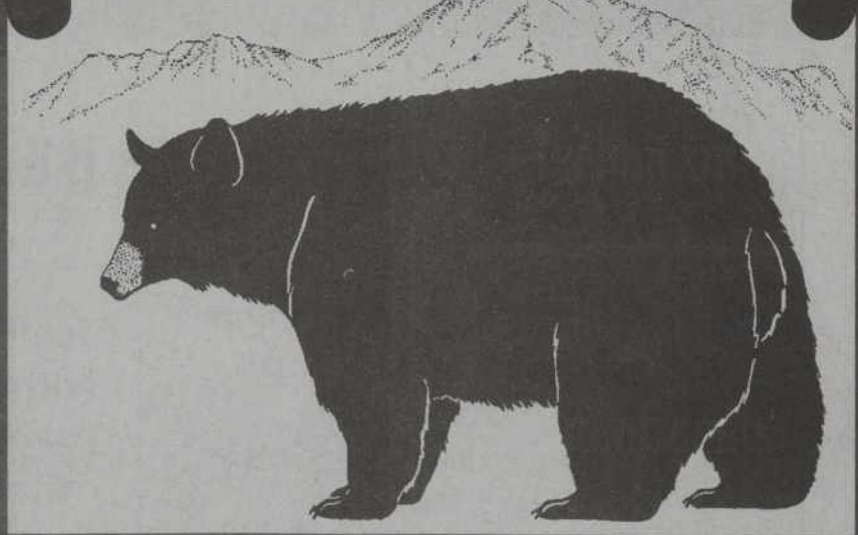
Smith is the son of Ronna and Ryan Smith.
