

Members encouraged to vote

Tribal members can vote in the November 7 general election by bringing their ballots to the Warm Springs Library in the Family Resource Center.

A ballot box will be at the library by the end of this week, and will be available until the election deadline, which is 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 7.

On Election Day from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. there will be an all-day event at the Resource Center, encouraging voter participation. Lunch will be served at the center on Nov. 7 from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

If people have not yet filled out their ballot by Election Day, they can come to the Family Resource Center, where voter information material will be available, said Julie Quaid, of the Warm Springs Get Out To Vote Committee.

A recent voter registration drive on the reservation was a success, said Quaid.

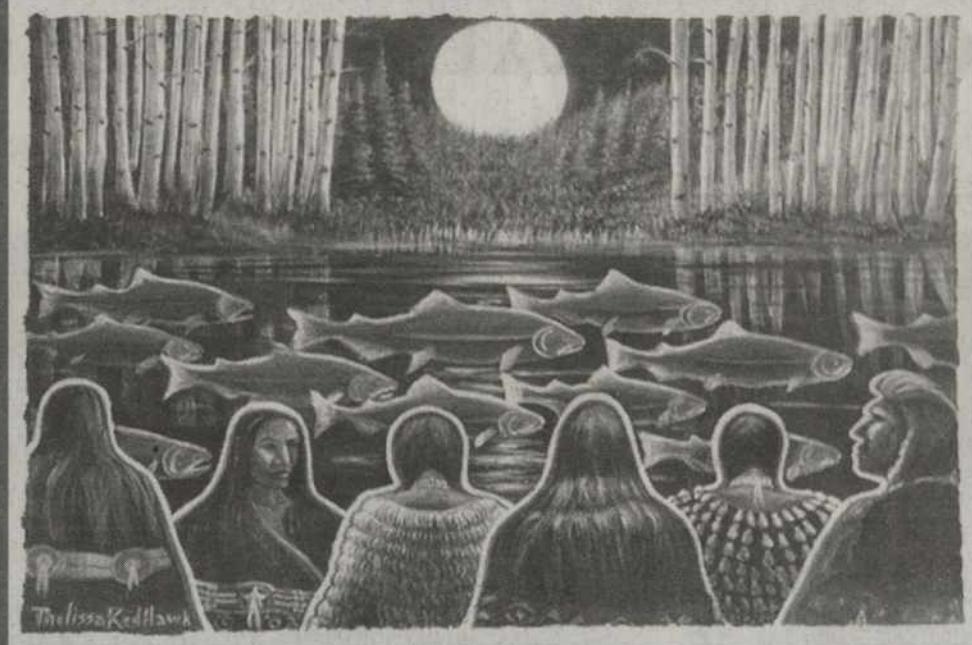
The reservation now has about 1,020 registered voters. About 850 are in Jefferson County, and another 210 are in Wasco County.

"We have many voters, and

we want to help make sure they vote," said Quaid.

Among the items on the ballot is the U.S. House of Representatives Second Congressional District of Oregon, which includes the reservation and ceded lands.

The position of governor is on the ballot, and the Oregon House of Representatives 59th District seat, which includes Warm Springs, as are local positions such as two county commissioner seats, and sheriff of Jefferson County.

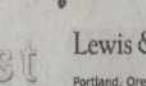
