Marriage dissolution

To Charles Evan Frank and Angel Wells-Frank: This is notice that a dissolution of marriage has been scheduled with the Tribal Court. By this notice you are summoned to appear in this matter at a hearing scheduled for November 27, 2006 at 1 p.m. at the Warm Springs Tribal Court. All of the facts of the case will be heard at this hearing including evidence you wish to present. You must appear to present your argument of the other side may automatically win; petitioner/plaintiff Charles Evan Frank may then be granted all that is asked for in the attached petition. Both parties to this action may be represented by counsel, or may elect to represent themselves. If you cannot be present, you may have your approved legal council appear on your behalf at your own expense. Representation must be approved by the presiding judge. To ensure the rules governing admissibility to practice are met there, a spokesperson form must be submitted at least five working days prior to the hearing. If you have any questions, you should seek legal advice immediately. Failure to obtain legal counsel prior to the hearing is not sufficient cause to

reschedule the hearing.

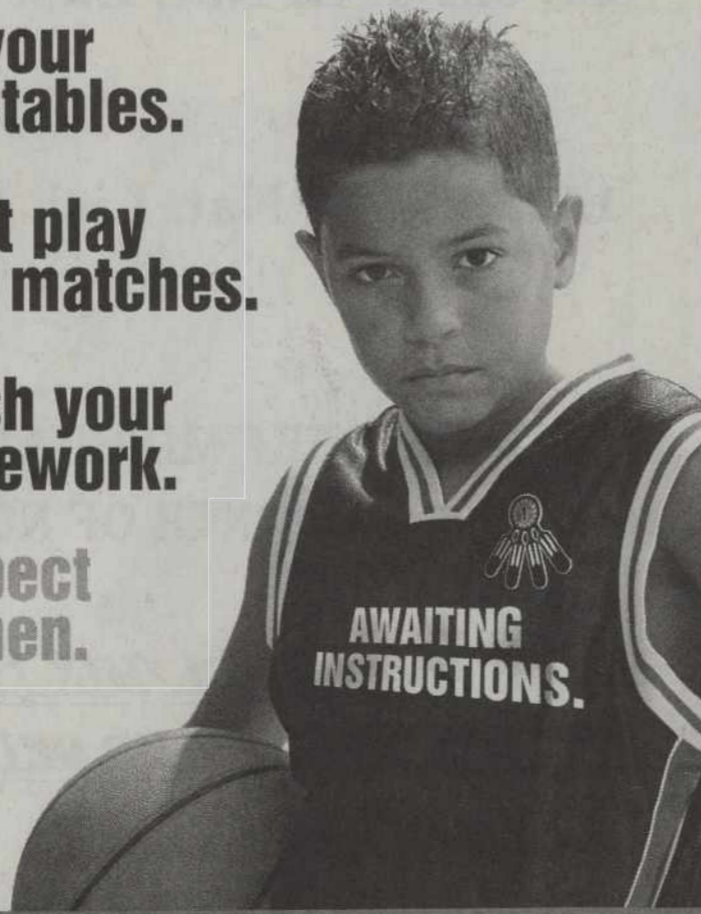
