

Several buildings vandalized

The Education Building was broken into last week, and significant property damage was reported.

Doors and locks to the offices of Culture and Heritage Department, and various offices of the Education Branch were broken.

A laptop computer was reported stolen, and the employee desks were ransacked. The per-

son or people responsible also discharged a fire extinguisher in a room on the second floor of the building. The pop machines were broken open.

"If it's tribal people who are doing this, they should realize it is their own money that is used to fix this," said Myra Shawaway, director of Culture and Heritage.

Other buildings were reported to have been damaged

about the same time as the Education Building.

The Children's Protective Services building, the clinic, and the Early Childhood Education Center were all reportedly vandalized or damaged, according to unconfirmed reports.

The Warm Springs Police Department was not available to comment as of press time for this publication.
