Eel season open at falls

Eel fishing season is open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday at Willamette Falls. The season lasts through July 31. The open area is the east

side of the falls, east of the horseshoe. Hand tools only. The tribes will monitor tribal members' harvest, and will be issuing permits to harvesters.

Please contact the tribes for specific requirements and permits before harvesting eels. Natural Resources can be reached at 553-2001.

Hunter safety classes begin this month

Hunter's safety education classes will start at the end of this month.

Classes will be held on the following dates: July 24, 26, 31; August 2 as a field day; 3 test days and possible make up day on the 6.

Each class session will be four hours long with an all-day field day.

Students must be 12 years of age to take the hunters safety courses. Classes will be held at the Cougar Den at the Natural Resources building at 4223 Holliday Street, located at the Industrial Park next to Fire Management and the Forestry Compound.

Classes begin at 4:30 p.m. on the 24, 26 and 31.

On August 3 the field day will begin at 8:30 a.m. and last until 4:30 p.m.

The hunter's safety classes require 20 hours for completion, so students will not be able to miss class time.

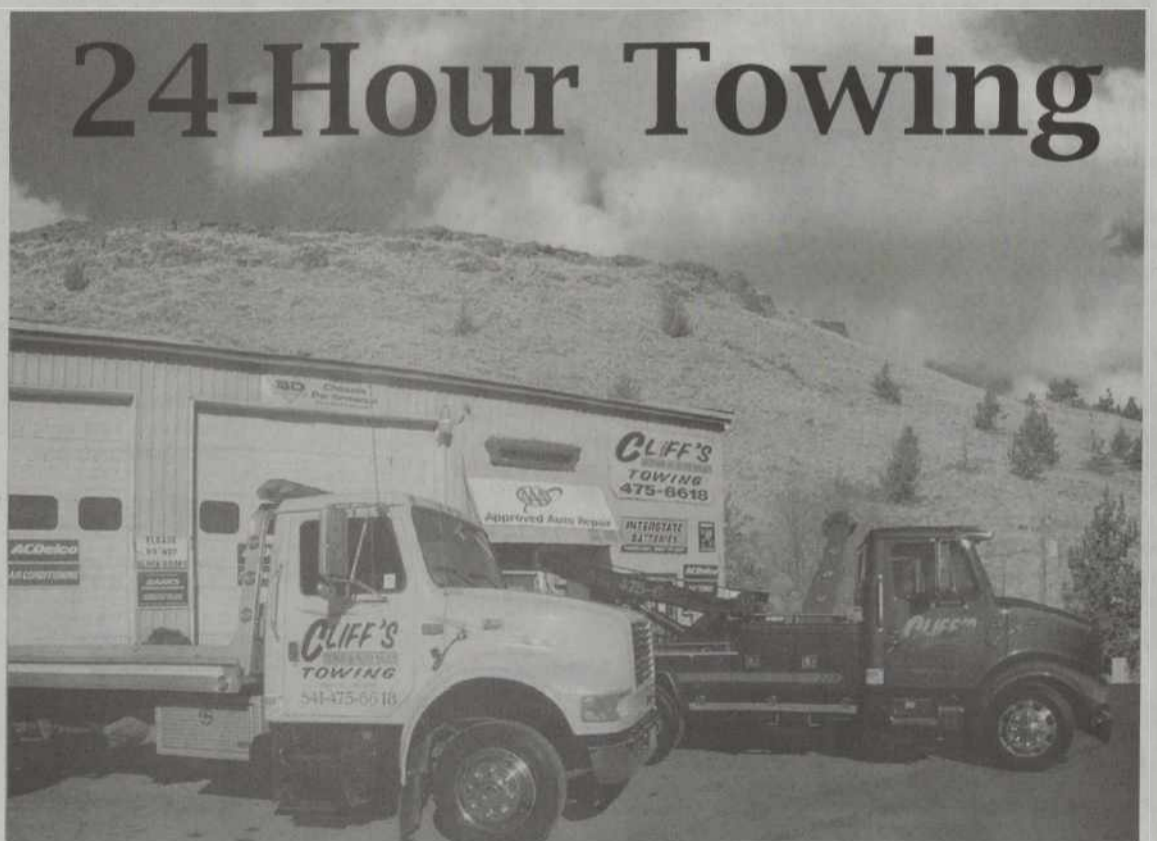
