With \$239.1 million in expenses, that would leave a \$3 in Cascade Locks approved million projected cash profit for a trust in order to conafter one year.

However, after five years the projected cash profit should total about \$65 million.

After 10 years, the Bridge of the Gods casino's projected revenues total about \$406.6 million. With \$274.9 million in ex-

penses, that would total a \$131.7 million cash profit for the tribes.

After that, Arnett said, five public meetings will be held regarding the matter—one in Warm Springs, three throughout the Columbia Gorge, and the final meeting in the Portland area.
