

Police eradicate pot growing operation

The Warm Springs Police Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration recently executed a search warrant following a month-long investigation into an illegal marijuana growing operation on the reservation.

Detectives found and eradicated two separate marijuana growing operations in the northeast corner of the Warm Springs Reservation, commonly known as the Mutton Mountain area, specifically Eagle Creek.

Approximately 17,763 plants were eradicated. The total estimated street value for these plants was \$1,776,300.

No suspects were found at the time the warrants were executed.

The case is still being investigated, as other evidence found in the area may lead to suspect identities.

Drug Enforcement Administration officers were assisted by the Wasco County Sheriff's Office,

The Dalles Police, the BIA, the FBI, the Oregon National Guard, the BLM, the Civil Air

Patrol, Warm Springs Fire and Safety, and Warm Springs Fire Management.

Stabbing leads to charge of voluntary manslaughter

Glenn R. Brunoe Sr. has been charged with voluntary manslaughter in the recent death of Michael Kalama.

The incident happened in September at a residence on Juniper Street in Warm Springs.

Police responded to a 9-1-1 call regarding a fight in progress. When police arrived, within two minutes of the call, they found the victim lying on the ground, having been stabbed with a knife several times.

Brunoe had fled on foot,

according to a report by the FBI.

Meanwhile, Kalama was transported by ambulance to Mountain View Hospital, where he died from stab wounds.

A witness reported that Brunoe was at the residence on Juniper Street during the evening when Kalama also arrived.

The men began to argue, according to the report, and the argument escalated into a fight during which Kalama was stabbed.

The next day police arrested Brunoe, after he had been

jumped and beaten by three other individuals, according to the report of the FBI officer.

Brunoe was treated at Mountain View for his injuries, and was then interviewed by investigators, the report says.

Based on the investigation of the case, the U.S. Attorney's Office filed a criminal complaint of voluntary manslaughter against Brunoe in federal court in Portland.

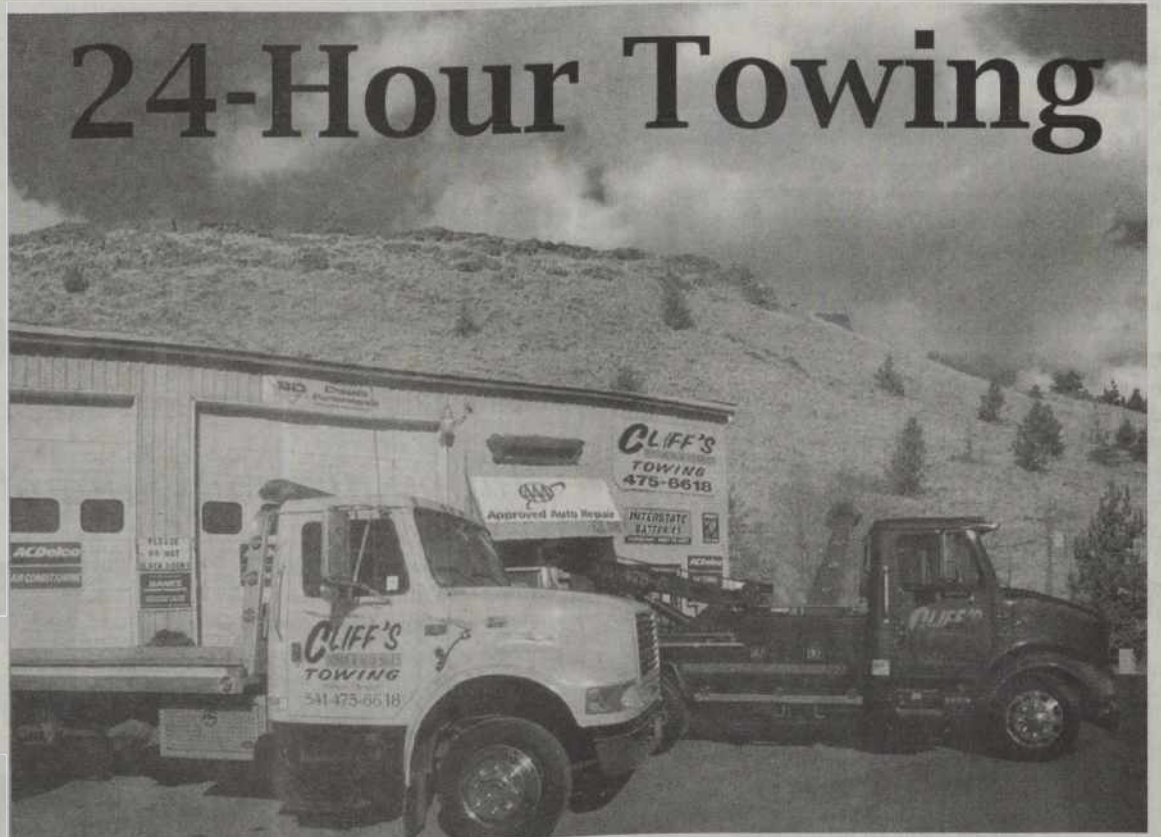
