

Tribal Council seeks to fill board vacancies

The Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs would like to advertise the following board positions. People interested in serving on one of the boards should submit a letter of interest and resume no later than Wednesday, Jan. 3. Letters and resumes should be sent to:

Authorization letter will be mailed to all applicants for a criminal and credit background check to be completed and returned to the Secretary-Treasurer's office. Information will be submitted confidentially to the Secretary-Treasurer.

Warm Springs Composite Board of Directors, three positions: One tribal member and

one non-tribal member (class III); and one tribal member (class I).

Regular meetings of the Board of Directors are held quarterly on the third Monday in the months of February, May, August and November for the purpose of reviewing the preceding three months' operations, making plans for the ensuing three months' operations, and the transaction of such other business as may come before the meeting. The first regular meeting in each fiscal year shall also be the annual meeting of the Board of Directors.

Warm Springs Credit Board of Directors, two positions: tribal member and on-tribal member, Class II.

Regular meetings of the

Board of Directors shall be held quarterly for the purpose of reviewing the preceding three months' operations, making plans for the ensuing three months' operations, and the transaction of such other business as may come before this meeting. The first regular meeting in each fiscal year shall also be the annual meeting of the Board of Directors.

Kah-Nee-Ta High Desert Resort and Casino Board of Directors, three positions: two tribal members, one non-member, class I.

Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held not less often than quarterly for the purpose of reviewing the preceding three months' opera-

tions, making plans for the ensuing three months' operations, and the transaction of such other business as may come before the meeting. The first regular meeting in each fiscal year shall also be the annual meeting of the Board of Directors.

Water Control Board, one position.

The Tribal Council has the responsibility for managing the water resource of the reservation through the Reservation Water Management Plan. To implement this plan, Council established the Water Control Board.

Primary function of the board is to review all matters pertaining to the water resource to make recommendations to the Tribal Council in regards to making the Water Management Plan function and to propose changes or improvements in water policy and the plan.

The Water Control Board will be concerned with all activities occurring in the watershed areas on the Reservation. Before an activity is initiated all plans will be submitted to the Board for their recommendations to the Tribal Council to ensure that neither water quality or quantity is impaired.

Term to begin: January,

2008, ending October 30, 2010 (three-year term).

Warm Springs Forest Products Industry Board of Directors, two positions, one tribal member, one non-member, class III.

Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held quarterly on the second Monday in the months of February, May, August and November for the purpose of reviewing the preceding three months' operations, making plans for the ensuing three months' operations, and the transaction of such other business as may come before the meeting. The first regular meeting in each fiscal year shall also be the annual meeting of the Board of Directors.

Warm Springs Water and Power Enterprises Board of Directors, one position, tribal member, class I.

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held annually on the fourth Thursday in the month of March for the purpose of reviewing the preceding calendar year's operations, and the transaction of such other business as may come before the meeting.

Coordinator needed for Miss Warm Springs program

The Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs would like to advertise the following: Miss Warm Springs Coordinator, one tribal member.

The coordinator is needed to assist the Miss Warm Springs Royalty in planning activities and travel in behalf of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs. Majority of activities will be local events, such as Lincoln's Powwow, Pi-Ume-Sha Powwow, parades, county fairs, and other events.

The coordinator will be responsible for overseeing the tribal budget for the Miss Warm Springs, coordinating the processing of travel with the Administrative Service Center travel coordinator; ensuring that funds are available and that necessary paperwork is available to ensure travel for the royalty to events as approved by Tribal Council; plan and recruit for the next year's royalty.

This position is voluntary. Knowledge of the tribal activities and culture is helpful. Letters of interest and resumes of applicants interested in serving should be submitted to the following address by no later than January 3, 2008:

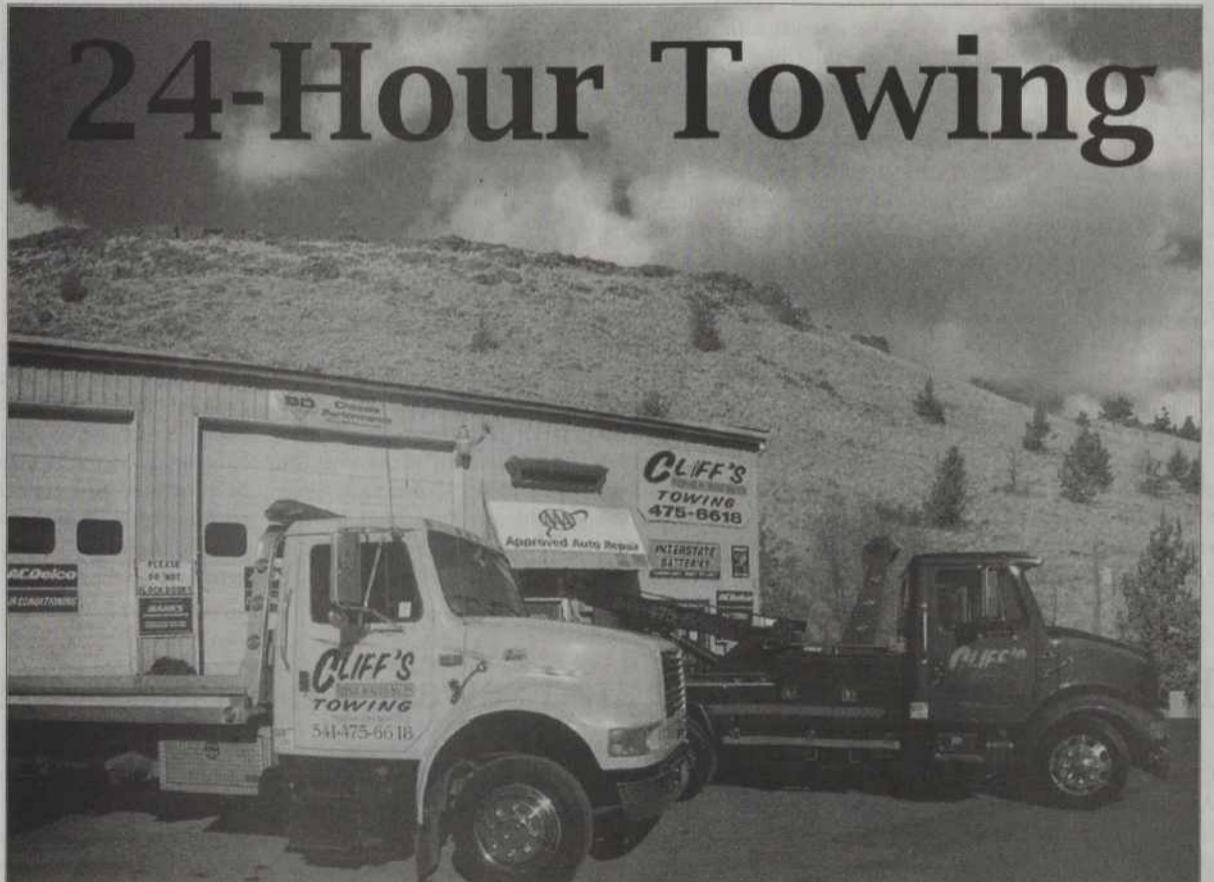
