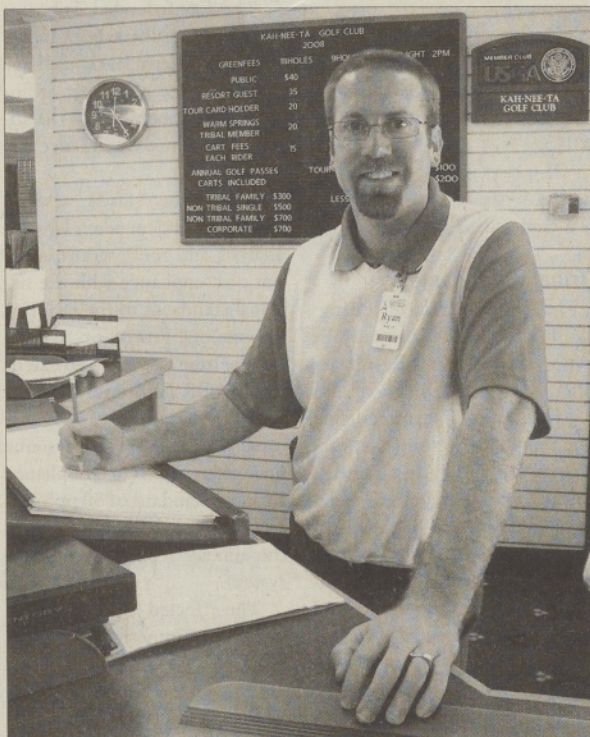

Maki teaches clinics on short game (Fridays), irons and approach (Saturdays) and fairway woods and drivers (Sundays). These clinics are \$30 per person per day; or the weekend game improvement clinic package is \$75 per person, and includes the Friday, Saturday and Sunday clinics.

Lessons by appointment with Maki are on Mondays and Wednesdays all day; on Tuesdays and Thursdays after 2 p.m.; on Fridays until 3 p.m.; and on Saturdays and Sundays after 12 p.m.

The pro shop can be reached at 553-4971.

Lessons are \$40 an hour for tribal members and employees; \$30 an hour for juniors 17 and under; \$60 an hour for resort guests and the general public; \$100 an hour for a family up to five people. Video lessons are \$80 an hour.

There is a new fee schedule at Kah-Nee-Ta, which makes playing this year very affordable at the resort. The annual pass program, which includes use of a cart, is as follows:

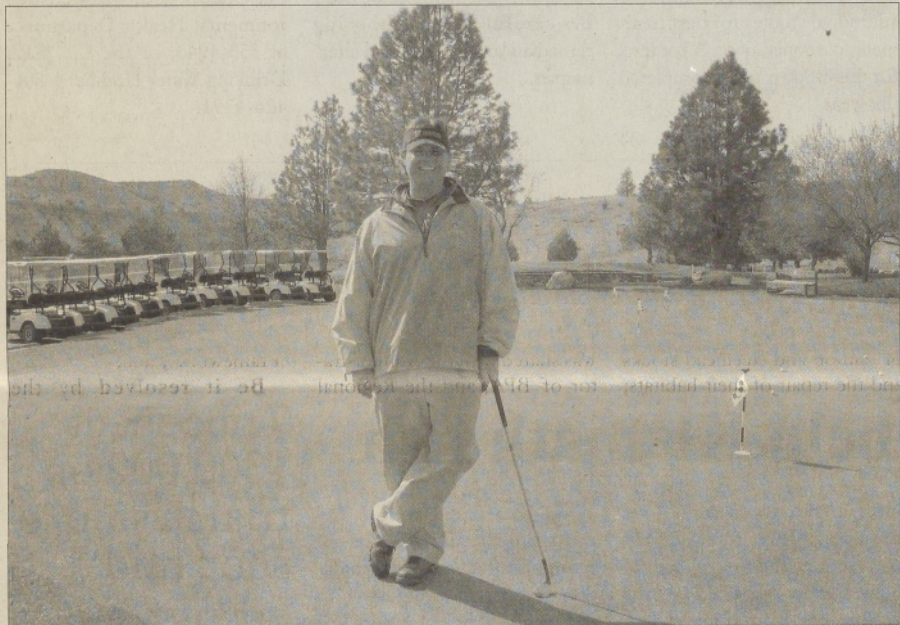
Tribal member family annual golf pass, \$300.

Non-tribal member family annual golf pass, \$700.

Business/corporate annual golf pass, \$700.

For instance, she said, at the high school they cut licensed staff with the teen parent program in order to keep child care options for teen parents.

The cuts also tighten non-staff cuts across the district, Baker said, including supply budgets, bus replacements, technology purchases and other developments.

Though the budget will be

reduced, Baker added, they strive to continue the district's commitment to student achievement.

The budget committee will meet with the public during meeting on April 22, April 29 and May 6. All meetings are at 7 p.m. The committee will adopt a final budget on June 23.

Community members are welcome to give their input at upcoming budget meetings, but

comments should be kept to a three-minute time frame. All meetings are held at the district office or at Buff Elementary if a large crowd is expected.
