DO52-08: Based upon complaints/petitions filed with this court, this court hereby orders Shirley Chamema-Smith to restrain herself from any type of disruptive/stressful behavior at the elders home, if she is under the influence of intoxicants, consuming or possessing alcoholic beverages/illegal drugs inside/outside the elder's residence. Bringing intoxicated, disruptive or disrespectful friends to the elder's home. Causing, creating or allowing a situation that can result in the elder's stress by disruptive, disorderly or disrespectful behavior (including domestic violence) at the elder's home. Alvis Smith Sr., a respective elder of our community. This order shall remain in effect until June 10, 2008 at 10 a.m. Failure to abide by this order will result with you being arrested and brought before the court and/or to the contempt of court and/or elder abuse charges, for which the court may sentence you to serve up to 90 days in jail and up to a \$500 fine, pursuant to Warm Springs Tribal Codes 200.610 contempt of court and 331.950 enforcement of elder abuse orders.
