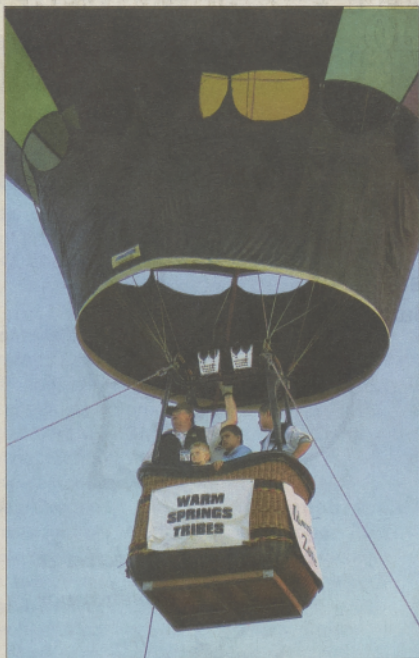

Home stay hosts needed

The Oregon State University Extension Office at Warm Springs is seeking Warm Springs families who are willing to host OSU college students in their homes during a three-day study/community service trip to Warm Springs in mid-September.

Approximately 17 graduate students will be in the community and will need housing for three nights on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, Sept. 11-13, and departing on Sunday, Sept. 14.

The families will need to provide beds and linens for two students plus breakfast for three mornings, and be willing to visit and help them learn about the community. A stipend of approximately \$150 will be paid to the families for each pair of students hosted for three nights. Approximately 8 families are needed.
