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## In the Tribal Court of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs

Dawn Rowland, petitioner, vs. James Smith Jr., respondent, case no. RO17-08. On the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2008, the court issued an ex parte temporary restraining order in the above case enjoining the above named respondent from contacting petitioner in any manner and at certain places within the Warm Springs Reservation until a hearing could be held to determine whether respondent should be further restrained from petitioner. On the 27 day of May, 2008 at 11 a.m. the court held such hearing and finds the following: Petitioner appeared in person or by representation; respondent did not appear. Both parties having proper notice restraining order was printed in the Spilyay April 24, 2008 edition and opportunity to be heard, the court finds that there is sufficient evidence to further enjoin respondent

from contact with petitioner, and hereby orders that: the restraining order again the respondent is continued the 26<sup>th</sup> of May, 2009, as set out in the ex parte temporary restraining order; and the following conditions are added to the same: refrain from residence at 8427 Sidwalter Rd. and babysitter residence 7402 S-300; and minors Micha Smith (6/12/02), Nikita Smith (10/4/04), Inez Smith (1/17/07). So ordered May 27, 2008.

Naomi Brisbois, petitioner; Brenda Strom, respondent, case no. RO28-08: Based upon complaints/petitions filed with this court, this court hereby orders Brenda Strom to restrain himself/herself from Naomi Brisbois from any manner of communication or contact in any public or pri-

ivate place including residence 1633 Foster St.; minor Annalese James (3/18/07); employment at Administration Building/Management Department; no third party contact, no phone calls/texting or mail, or public places on the Warm Springs Reservation; no off-reservation contact under the influence of intoxicants or drugs. No threatening gestures. There is to be no phone contact. This order shall remain in effect until show cause hearing. Both petitioner and respondent are subject to contempt of court if fails to comply with the court restraining order. You are hereby ordered to appear before the Warm Springs Tribal Court on July 7, 2008 at 11 a.m. to show cause why this restraining order should or should not remain in effect. If you fail to appear as so ordered, the hearing will proceed and a decision rendered.

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
