

House fire claims two lives

The tribal Police Department and the FBI are investigating a house fire that happened May 28 in the West Hills neighborhood of Warm Springs. The fire claimed the lives of Mariel Lydia Frank, 49, and Chesley Yahtin Jr.,

43. The case was still being investigated at press time, but police released the following information: Police and Warm Springs Fire Department were alerted, through a 9-1-1 call, during the

early morning hours of Wednesday, May 28, said Warm Springs Police Chief Carmen Smith. The caller stated that the residence at 1678 Shepard Lane was on fire. The fire department responded and extinguished the fire. The structure received ex-

tensive damage. After the fire was extinguished, fire fighters located the bodies of Ms. Frank and Mr. Yahtin in the residence. The fire occurred under suspicious circumstances, and is being investigated.

Man wanted in region arrested on reservation

A Madras man who was wanted on warrants in Jefferson and Deschutes counties was arrested last week in Warm Springs.

Warm Springs police arrested Carl Williams III, 28, on Tuesday, May 27.

Williams had been identified as the subject involved in two weekend incidents during which he eluded State Police, county sheriffs' deputies, and city police officers.

Officers in Redmond, Madras, Bend and Prineville were on the look-out for Williams.

During one of the weekend incidents, while attempting to

elude Deschutes County officers, Williams allegedly drove at a speed of 50 mph through the parking lot of the Cascade Village Shopping Center in Bend, nearly striking several pedestrians.

He then parked the car and fled, leaving the passenger, Azrael Rose Mary, 20, of Prineville, who was then charged with possession of methamphetamine and hashish, according to police reports.

Williams eluded police until he was arrested by Warm Springs Police. At the time, the tribes apparently had an exclusion order against Williams.
