The theme for the Fourth of July celebration in Warm Springs this year is, "Red, White and Blue, Strong Proud and True." Fourth of July Parade begins on the Campus area at 11 a.m.

Parade preparation and decorating starts at 9 a.m., with the line-up and judging beginning at 10 a.m. After the parade, the community barbecue will start at 12:30 p.m.

Games and prizes start at 2 p.m., sponsored by Primary Prevention. Activities include sack race, three-legged race, water slide, canoe race, water balloon toss, watermelon eating contest, relay games.

Fireworks, presented by Wester Display Fireworks, begin after dark at the Community Center area. The Warm Springs community events are made sponsored by the Confederated Tribes, Warm Springs Market, Primary Prevention, and the Community Center and Recreation Department.

## Endangered sockeye beat projections

(AP) - Sockeye salmon are swimming up the Columbia River in Oregon and Washington in higher-than-expected numbers. More than 157,000 fish had been counted at Bonneville Dam on the Lower Columbia River by last week. It's a number that is about double the 75,600 projection made before the spawning season, according to the Idaho Statesman.

Joe Hymers, with the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife, said he's never seen a sockeye count of 100,000 this

early in the year. But he and other scientists are at a loss when it comes to explaining the robust run, which is about six times the total for all of last year.

"It's a mystery. This is nothing like what was predicted," said Brian Gorman, a spokesman for the NOAA National Marine Fisheries Service.

Increases in this year's sockeye run were expected, though, because of improved river migration and ocean conditions, plus more young fish migrating from Idaho.
