In the Tribal Court of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs

In the matter of Victoria Muldrow, proposed ward, and Anna Lopez, petitioner, Case no. DO56-08. To Victoria Muldrow, Anna Lopez, Tyrone Muldrow, Marcus Muldrow, Angela Martinez, Dempson Polk, Phillis Tohet, Jerry Polk:

This is notice that a petition for conservator/guardian has been scheduled with the Warm Springs Tribal Court. By this notice you are summoned to appear in this matter at a hearing scheduled for 1:30 p.m. on August 21, 2008 at the Warm Springs Tribal Court. All of the facts of the case will be heard at this hearing, including evidence you wish to present. You must appear to present your argument or the other side will automatically win. The petitioner, Anna Lopez, may then be given all that is asked for in the petition.

Both parties to this action may be represented by counsel, or may elect to represent themselves. If you cannot be present, you may have your approved legal council appear on your behalf at your own expense. Representation must be approved by presiding judge to ensure the rules governing ad-

missibility to practice are met; therefore, a spokesperson form must be submitted at least five days prior to the hearing. If you have any questions, you should seek legal advice immediately. Failure to obtain legal counsel prior to the hearing is not sufficient cause to reschedule hearing.

Notice to the Warm Springs community

As of Friday, May 30, 2008, Raymond Gene Smith is hereby permanently revoked from representing anyone before the Warm Springs Tribal Court.

If you have a pending agreement with Mr. Smith to act as a spokesperson for you, the Court sug-

gests:

(1) you contact Mr. Smith immediately to arrange for him to refund you any money or other type of payment you have made to him, and,

(2) arrange for a licensed spokesperson or attorney to take over your case.

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
