**Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs vs. Chet Van Pelt, defendant, case no. CR654-07.** To Chet Van Pelt: You are hereby notified that the above cited case, as filed in the Warm Springs Tribal Court, has been scheduled for trial/hearing at 9 a.m. on September 25, 2008. You are hereby ordered to be and appear at the Warm Springs Tribal Court at the time and date shown to defend against the charge(s). You may be represented by yourself, by an attorney or by a spokesperson, at your own expense. You may bring any documents you believe are relevant to this cause, and you may bring witnesses to testify on your behalf. You may request the court to subpoena you witnesses, however, you must submit your list of witnesses no later than two weeks prior to trial; failure to do so will not be considered sufficient reason to postpone the trial. If you have questions, you should seek legal advice immediately. If you fail to appear as so ordered, the tribal court may enter a complaint for contempt of court and issue a warrant for your arrest.

If you cannot be present, you may have your approved legal counsel appear on your behalf at your own expense.
