Full closure of Biggs Bridge has been re-scheduled to begin on Monday, Sept. 8.

Earlier, full closure had been scheduled to begin on Sept. 3.

After Sept. 8, the bridge will

remain closed 24 hours a day, seven days a week until Dec. 30.

For now, there is partial closure of the bridge. The partial closure is at nighttime, when a single lane is closed and the open

lane controlled by flaggers at the Biggs Bridge.

The partial closure is from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., and will continue through until the full closure date.

resses that do not meet these standards. For more information contact the Land Services Office at 553-3270.



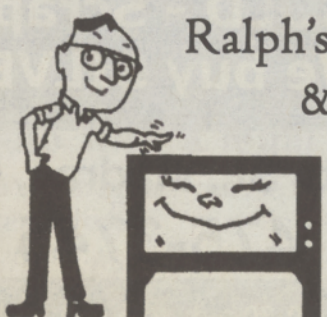
