Extension offers free testing of pressure canners

It is harvest time and to some that also means that it is canning time.

For those who are using pressure canners to can low-acid foods or meats now is the time to get your pressure canner gauge tested.

It is recommended that dial gauge pressure canner lids be checked at the beginning of each canning season to test for accuracy to ensure that foods are processed at the correct pressure for safety.

Warm Springs OSU Extension offers this service each year free of charge.

Just bring your pressure canner lid to the OSU Extension office at the Education Building.

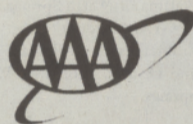
