## In the Tribal Court of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs

### Exclusion orders

**Warm Springs Confederated Tribes, plaintiff, vs. Michael Jim, defendant, case no. CR586-08:**  
It is hereby ordered and adjudged that the defendant is excluded permanently from the Warm Springs Indian Reservation for a period of two years. Compliance with this exclusion order may be enforced by the contempt power of the tribal court in accordance with Chapter 200 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code. If the defendant is found on the reservation in violation of this exclusion order the court may impose jail, fine or both for contempt of court, in addition to violations of Warm Springs Tribal Code Chapter 300, the tribal exclusion code.

**Warm Springs Confederated Tribes, plaintiff, vs. Jeremy Killsfirst Sr., defendant. Case no. CR672-08:**

It is hereby ordered and adjudged that the defendant is excluded permanently from the Warm Springs Indian Reservation for a period of two years. Compliance with this exclusion order may be enforced by the contempt power of the tribal court in accordance with Chapter 200 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code. If the defendant is found on the reservation in violation of this exclusion order the court may impose jail, fine or both for contempt of court, in addition to violations of Warm Springs

Tribal Code Chapter 300, the tribal exclusion code.

**Warm Springs Confederated Tribes, plaintiff, vs. Dana Hardin, defendant, case no. CV158-08:**

It is hereby ordered and adjudged that the defendant is excluded permanently from the Warm Springs Indian Reservation. Compliance with this exclusion order may be enforced by the contempt power of the tribal court in accordance with chapter 200 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code. If the defendant is found on the reservation in violation of this exclusion order the court may impose jail, fine or both for contempt of court, in addition to violations of Warm Springs Tribal Code chapter 300, the tribal exclusion code.
