Telco

Individual buildings would then connect to the cable, which would provide telephone, internet and digital television service. The telco would also require its own office building.

The telco, costing multiple millions of dollars, would not be possible without the existence of the universal service fund, which exists in order to bring telecommunication service to rural parts of the country.

Utility bills include a fee that goes to the fund, which can be difficult for companies to gain access to.

A company that serves an urban population, for instance, cannot gain access to the universal service funds.

In developing the telco, it appears quite possible that the Confederated Tribes could access the universal service fund, said Anspach. The telco—with its goal of connecting rural areas to the digi-

tal information system—meets the key criteria for gaining access to the fund, he said. Once the system is in place, there is another fund that could help the rural customers pay their bills to the telco, said Anspach.

In a report to Tribal Council, Anspach summarized some of the benefits of developing the tribal telco. The benefits include:

Economic development, job and business creation, as proven by nine other tribes.

State of the art telecommunication service to the homes and offices on the reservation.

Improved public safety through better communications. Improved communication among the tribes, as Council and other meetings could be broadcast through live video streaming.

More education opportunities through distance learning. Better health care through tele-health systems.

The telco, said Anspach, "would open up a whole world of opportunities."
