

Comedy duo returns to Kah-Nee-Ta

What do you call a fair skinned Scandinavian from Mountain Home, Idaho and a Sioux Indian from Pierre, South Dakota?

The Indian and the White Guy, of course.

The Indian and the White Guy, also known as Williams and Ree, will perform in February at Kah-Nee-Ta High Desert Resort and Casino.

The comedy duo will perform on Saturday, Feb. 28, at Kah-Nee-Ta.

The team shares a unique ability to make people laugh even if it comes from laughing at themselves—a trait which first drew them together in 1968.

Bruce Williams and Terry Ree met at Black Hills State College in Spearfish, South Dakota, “where they were both majoring in draft dodging,” as they say.

The two ended up playing together in a band, working the bars and college parties. The band, with a repertoire of 10 or 12 songs needed help filling in the time; so Bruce and Terry jumped in with the ethnic jocular

Soon their comedy became a bigger draw than the band and The Indian and the White Guy comedy team was born.

The two have been performing together since those college days, and have been compared to the likes of “cotton and polyester,” “bourbon and water,”

“peas and carrots,” “Sears and Roebuck,”

During the late 70's they polished their act at the famous Comedy Store in Los Angeles. Terry points out that “the place is sort of a comedy college and is a great place to fine tune your material and see if the bits are working or not.”

He said, “We probably get most of our ideas from newspapers and television. Some absurdity will spark an idea and them we'll work it into something. A testing ground like the Comedy Store is a perfect place to try things out.”

For the past 26 years, the two have entertained audiences from coast to coast—sharing stages with such superstars as Garth Brooks, the Oak Ridge Boys, Charlie Daniels, and Randy Travis.

Their show is a lively, fast-paced mixture of comedy bits, and social and political commentary entwined with original songs.

Williams and Ree will perform in the Gold Ballroom at Kah-Nee-Ta on Feb. 28. Doors open at 7:30 p.m.

Tickets are \$15 for general admission and \$20 for reserved seating.
