In the matter of Conservator/Guardian: Gloria Mitchell, petitioner/plaintiff vs. Young Boise/Bernice Mitchell, respondent/defendant. Case no. JV91-07.

To Gloria Mitchell/Young Boise/Bernice Mitchell:

This is notice that a Conservator/Guardian has been scheduled with the tribal court. By this notice you are summoned to appear in this matter at a hearing scheduled for 9 a.m. on March 6, 2009 at the Warm Springs tribal court. All of the facts of the case will be heard at this hearing including evidence you wish to present. You must appear to present your argument or the other side may automatically win; Petitioner/Plaintiff Gloria Mitchell may then be granted all that is asked for in the attached petition.

Both parties to this action may be represented by counsel, or may elect to represent themselves. If you

cannot be present, you may have your approved legal council appear on your behalf at your own expense. Representation must be approved by the presiding judge to ensure the rules governing admissibility to practice are met; therefore, a spokesperson form must be submitted at least five working days prior to the hearing. If you have questions, you should seek legal advice immediately. Failure to obtain legal counsel prior to the hearing is not sufficient cause to reschedule hearing.

Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs vs. William Switzler, defendant. Case no. CR621-07.

To William Switzler:

You are hereby notified that the above cited case, as filed with the Warm Springs Tribal Court, has

been scheduled for trial/hearing at 9 a.m. on April 10, 2009. You are hereby ordered to be and appear at the Warm Springs Tribal Court at the time and date shown to defend against the charge(s). You may be represented by yourself, by an attorney or by a spokesperson at your own expense. You may bring any documents you believe are relevant to this cause, and you may bring witnesses to testify on your behalf. You may request the court to subpoena you witnesses; however, you must submit your list of witnesses no later than two weeks prior to trial; failure to do so will not be considered sufficient reason to postpone the trial. If you have questions, you should seek legal advice immediately. If you fail to appear as so ordered, the tribal court may enter a complaint for contempt of court and issue a warrant for your arrest.
