Fire Management: Squad Boss/Fuels (3 positions).

The Squad Boss is responsible for supervision of five (5) crew members in various work projects; carries out the planned work schedules and makes adjustments in work-load to meet the needs; plans for and picks up supplies and equipment; prepares the items for readiness; and inspects for safe use on all projects. Main duties are using power tools to remove juniper and brush, and will be required to fight fire under stressful conditions with hand and power tools from 8 – 16 hours.
