Family Services: CPS Protective Care Provider FT.

Provide daily care to children; infant to 18 years of age who are victims of abuse or neglect. Must be willing to provide nurturing care and understand the needs of these children. You are hereby ordered to be and appear at the Warm Springs Tribal Court at the time and date shown to defend against the

charge(s). You may be represented by yourself, by an attorney or by a spokesperson at your own expense. You may bring any documents believe are relevant to this cause, and you may bring witnesses to testify on your behalf. You may request the court to subpoena you witnesses, however, you must submit your list of witnesses no later than two weeks prior to trial; failure to do so will not be considered sufficient reason to postpone the trial. If you have questions you should seek legal advice immediately. If you fail to appear as so ordered, the court may enter a complaint for contempt of court and issue a warrant for your arrest.


Exclusion order

Warm Springs Confederated Tribes (plaintiff) vs. Aaron Wyngarden (defendant), case no. CV28-09:

It is here by ordered and adjudged that the defendant is excluded permanently from the Warm Springs Reservation. Compliance with this exclusion order may be enforced by the contempt power of the tribal court in accordance with Chapter 200 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code. If the defendant is found on the reservation in violation of this exclusion order the court may impose jail, fine or both for contempt of court, in addition to violations of Warm Springs Tribal Code Chapter 300, the tribal exclusion code.
