His piano teacher Jill Kickenlooper said, "Jeremy has been an adventure to teach. And I have observed that the more he learns, the more his creativity expands. He appreciates and explores all sounds and styles of music," she said.

"When he plays piano the limitations he has without music fall away. It is a wonder to see and hear."

"I think that the greatest joy in Jeremy's life is sharing his musical gift with others," said Don Ouimet, director of the Oregon School for the Blind. "He plays and gives from his heart."
