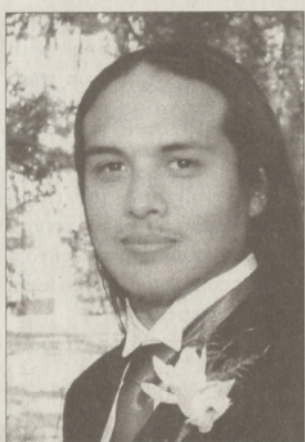
Reuben Paul "Chip" Santos, April 27, 1982-October 16, 2009.
