

Miss Warm Springs Pageant Jan. 22

The Miss Warm Springs Pageant is set for the evening of Friday, Jan. 22 at the Agency Longhouse.

Theresa Van Pelt, event coordinator, asks that contestants please turn in your entry forms to the Tribal Council office by Jan. 15 at 5 p.m., although she said would accept them up until the time of the pageant.

Qualifications and obligations

Interested applicants must be 18-24 years of age at the time of the pageant. The applicant must never have been married, cohabitating or have dependants.

The applicant must be drug and alcohol free, an enrolled member of the Con-

federated Tribes of Warm Springs, and a resident of the reservation for at least one year.

Also, the applicant must maintain residency on the reservation for a year after winning the title, although school will be taken into consideration.

The guidelines state:

As Miss Warm Springs, she will always maintain and present herself in a proper and responsible manner throughout her term, as will her alternate.

If for some reason Miss Warm Springs cannot meet her obligations, her alternate shall represent the tribes for the remainder of the reign.

Miss Warm Springs must be able to travel and represent the tribes during her reign in other pageants, social events, intertribal business and social events,

public relations functions and Council functions as requested.

Judging

Contestants will be judged on the following:

Knowledge of the reservation and her own tribe.

Poise, personality, beauty, speaking ability, appearance.

Knowledge of traditional foods, ceremonies, clothing, crafts and social activities.

A typed essay on "Why I want to be Miss Warm Springs." Completed official application form. Certificate or degree of Indian blood/tribal identification. For more information, please call the Tribal Council office at 553-3257.
