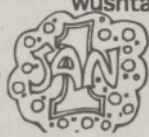

The month of December is called nch'i an in this language.

Walptaikash iwa maic'qipama ana ku wushtaimmat xaixtna.

there's songs sang to meet the dawn/sunrise.

Ana ku iwa wushushuwat wustaimat chmti anwichtna ku pa walptaikta putmt ku napt xush walptaikash,auku ikwn c'mst, auku anai tuskaski.

there are 12 songs sang first ,then 9 songs after that 7 songs are sang before meeting the new year.

Auku pa-at'ta, panknita amchni naikni kaatnamna,pawiyawalptaiksha walptaikash 'mni autni walptaikash ilaamktash miima watiakshna,auku pa-ashta kaatnamyau ku pawalpaikta mtaat waashat walpkaitash,

everyone walks around the longhouse singing the song to go around the longhouse as they erase their tracks from the old year.they then enter the longhouse and dance to three songs.



Ku pa-walptaikta ititamat walptaikash wushtaimatpama chmti anwichtna.

the bringing in the new year song will be sang wic his counting the months forward and then backwards,

Auku ikwn papa-wnpaita apap,papa-kwalanawasha chmti anwichtki.

then everyone shakes hands happy to meet the new year.

kwalanai chmti anwicht tlaax naimuma ku 'nxtwaima!

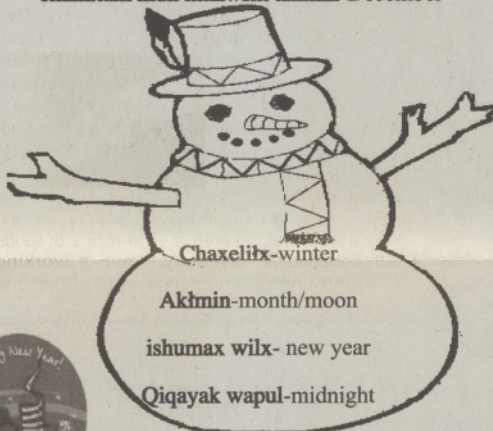
