The Tribal Council of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs would like to advertise the following:

Warm Springs Credit Enterprise Board of Directors

Regular meetings of the board are quarterly.

Kah-Nee-Ta High Desert Resort & Casino Board of Directors

Two positions: one tribal member and one non-member, Class I, terms expire December 31, 2013.

Each member of the board shall meet the qualifications and shall be subject to the same licensing requirements as are set forth in IGRA, the Compact and the Gaming Ordinance for a key management employee, provided, that no person shall serve as a member of the board while serving as a member of the Tribal Council.

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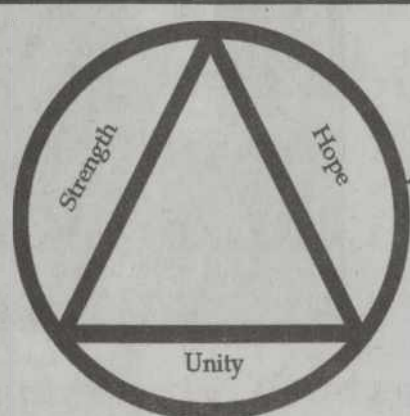
