

Tribal employees can cut their own tree—as long as they follow the rules

The Timber Committee of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation have consented to allow employees of the following organizations to cut a Christmas tree: The Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Indian Health Service, Warm Springs churches, and the U.S. Postal Service.

Cutting is limited to one tree per family or church. Trees will be cut on tribal land only. Trees should not be cut close to the ground and live branches should

not be removed from the stump. Topping of trees and cutting trees larger than 12 feet high is not permitted.

Trees also should not be cut that do not have another tree growing within 12 feet of the tree to be cut.

Trees must only be cut during regular work hours: 8 a.m. - 5 p.m., Monday-Friday.

Any non-tribal member employee wanting to cut a tree must obtain their Christmas tree tag from the Branch of Forestry. Individuals will not be allowed to

pickup tags for other employees. Tags must be stapled or nailed to the base of the tree when the tree is cut.

All employees must comply with all laws and regulations governing the Warm Springs Reservation.

Information on tribal land, harvest location and road conditions may be obtained from the Branch of Forestry when picking up a Christmas tree tag. Office hours are 6:30 a.m.-5 p.m., Monday-Friday.
