IT APPEARING TO THE COURT, from the petition filed herein that the decedent was an Indian who died on the 19th day of December, 2010, and at the time of death the decedent was domiciled or owned property situated within the Warm Springs Indian Reservation; that the decedent's estate consists of property which does not come within the jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Interior of the United States; that it is necessary to probate such estate and to appoint an Administrator and an Appraiser for this purpose; that **Kenneth L. Smith** is a competent person to perform the duties of Administrator and, that **Thomas Strong, Jr.**, is a disinterested and competent person to perform the duties of Appraiser, and upon filing his oath of office, shall be qualified so to serve.

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT, that the certain instrument in writing, dated 12th day of February, 2002, which has been filed herein and which purports to be the Last Will of the decedent, has been proved by the affidavit of one of the attesting witnesses to such will filed herein and is entitled to be admitted to Probate as the Last Will of the decedent; the Court being fully advised in the premises; now, therefore;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. That the estate of Zelma Smith, deceased, be probated pursuant to law in such cases made and provided;
 2. That the instrument in writing dated the 12th day of February, 2002, which has been filed herein, to be, and the same hereby is admitted to Probate as the Last Will of the decedent;

It is hereby ordered and adjudged that the defendant is excluded for two (2) years from the Warm Springs Indian Reservation, concurrent with all other existing exclusion orders. Compliance with this exclusion order may be enforced by the contempt power of the tribal court in accordance with Chapter 200 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code.
