Apprenticeship program supports traditional arts

The Traditional Arts Apprenticeship Program supports the sharing of traditional arts between a mentor and an apprentice. These traditional arts are defined as those artistic practices that have a community base and express that community's heritage.

This includes such communities as ethnic, tribal, occupational, regional and religious groups.

The skills are usually learned

informally and passed on from one generation to the next by observation and imitation.

Among the many traditional folk arts of Oregon are: Native American basket weaving, Southeast Asian dance, Mexican-American embroidery, Americana fiddling, African-American gospel singing, saddle making and rawhide braiding for working cowboys, and Northwest logger poetry.
