### High school, middle school sports physicals next week

School sports physicals will be held at the Warm Springs Health and Wellness Center at the clinic from 3:30-7 p.m. on Thursday, August 18.

Students will need to check in at the clinic front desk for the physicals.

All students at Jefferson County Middle School and Madras High School who are participating in any sport activity are required to have the physical every two years.

The sports physical education form is available now at the clinic for parents to pick up and complete.

The form needs to be filled out and signed by a parent or legal guardian before the physical is done.

Parents should accompany students to the exam.

Students 16 and under must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian for the exam:

Older brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles or friends cannot stand in for a parent during the physical.

If you cannot make this clinic, you may participate free of charge on Monday, August 15, at the sports physical clinic being held in Madras at the Methodist Church across the street from Mountain View Hospital.

The Warm Springs Health and Wellness Center will also be holding another sports exam clinic in September for those students who decide to participate in sports after school starts or who cannot make either of these sports physical exam times.
