The camp was interesting because they broke up the art into different age groups. Each

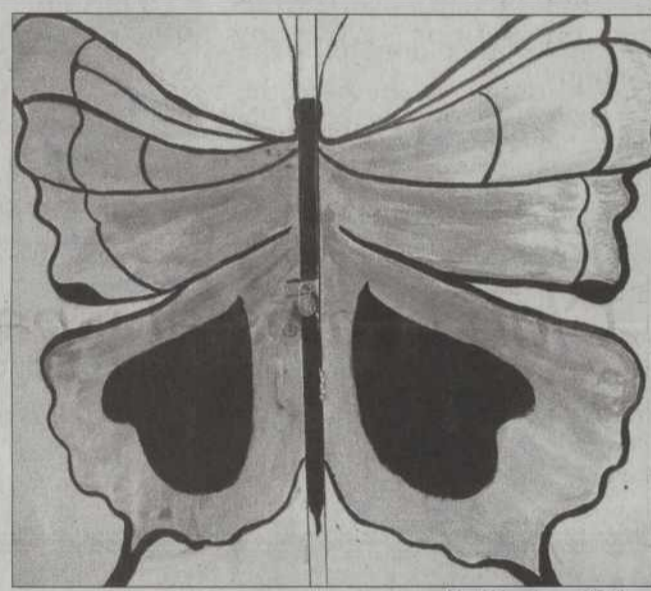
age group got a different project to work on, but first we were taught the basics of drawing and building or adding definition to make our projects look more realistic.

# Classes teach cake decoration
