The purpose of this event is to allow experienced Native American weavers to teach and learn from others in the field.

Weaving teachers will be from Warm Springs, Puyallup, Idaho, Neah Bay and other Pacific

Northwest communities.

Pre-registration is \$75 before July 27, and \$90 after or at the door. Weaving kit fees are payable to individual teachers. Kit fees are \$10 to \$75 depending on the class.
