Red flag warning from W.S. Fire Management

Warm Springs Fire Management this week continued a red flag warning for all of Warm Springs.

This was due in large part, early in the week, to the abundant dry lightning, said William Wilson, Fire Management logistics manager.

On Monday morning, after the overnight lightning storm, a fire detection flight was scheduled over the reservation.

Camp crews were informed to remain on the alert

for dispatch. The red flag warning "will continue into Wednesday evening," Wilson said earlier this week.

Fire Management teams were fully mobilized and patrolling the back roads.

Wilson asked residents to please report all fire activity. The contact number is 541-553-1146.

"Thank you to the community for your help, cooperation and support," Wilson said on behalf of Fire Management staff.
