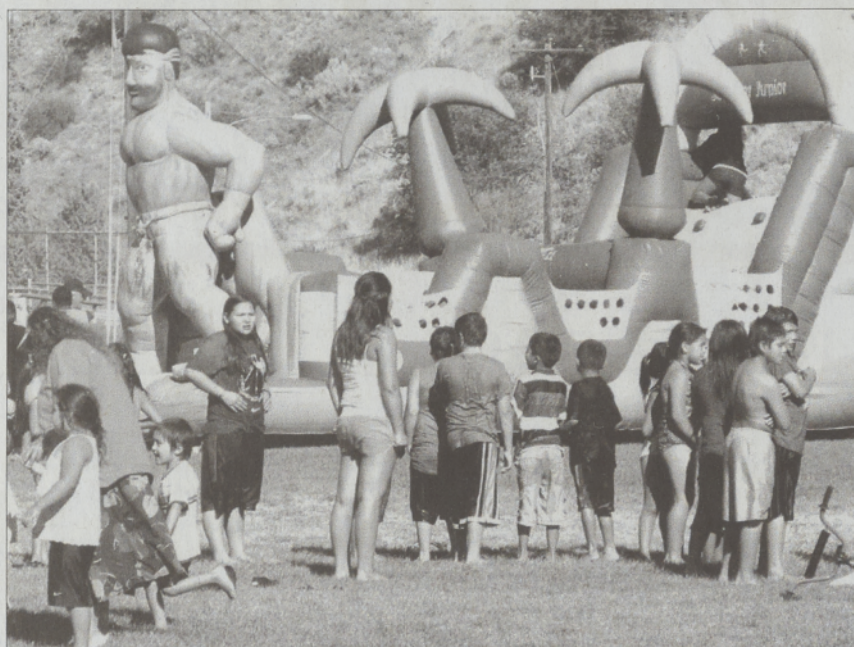


### At the Jamboree

Registration is during the first class on Sept. 24, and on Wednesday, Sept. 26.

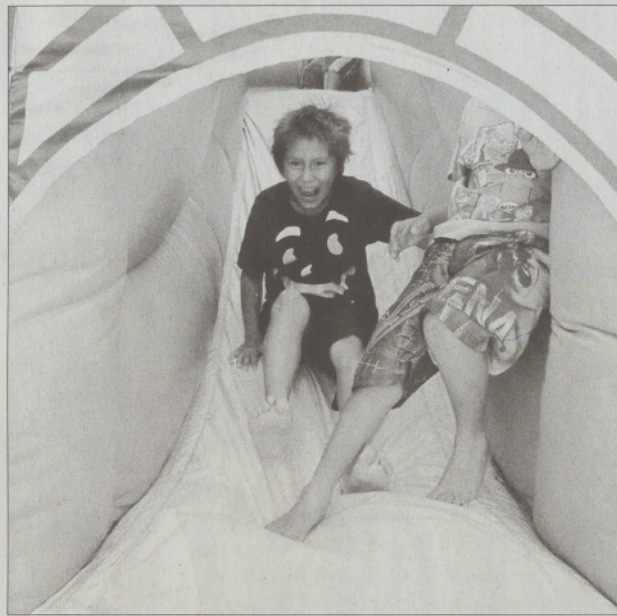
The classes are taught at
